## [Ophthalmology Service by Ophthalmologists]

#### **★** Service Charges ★

- The consultation fee & medicine fee for Ophthalmology service are charged separately and are subject to the updated price of our Centre. Please note that the price is subject to change without prior notice.
- For patients who hold a valid Comprehensive Social Security Assistance Letter or Medical Fee Waiver Certificate (original), the consultation fee will be reduced.
- Our Centre provides various follow-up services and treatment plans, all of which are charged independently. Each service charge is clear, please feel free to contact our staff or the Ophthalmologist for the details.
- If the patient decides to receive the service in private clinic of the Ophthalmologists or other medical institutions, the service charges & treatment procedures will be different from our Centre, all of which are determined by those private clinic or medical institutions. Our center will be unable to provide any relevant information or follow-up services.

### **★Payment Methods**★

- Cash, Octopus Card, WeChat Pay, AlipayHK and VISA, Master, UnionPay credit cards for amounts of HK\$150 or above are accepted.
- HCV is not accepted.

### **★Special Attention Items★**

- Ophthalmology service is only available from Monday to Friday (closed on Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays).
- The entire service takes 2-3 hours. In special circumstances, the consultation time may be longer.
- Since each Ophthalmologist's consultation period is different, our
   Center may not be able to arrange services for latecomers. Please

- come on time for consultation.
- If you need to apply for the following documents, please prepare them yourself and submit them to our staff at 1/F counter♀ Insurance claim documents filled in by Ophthalmologist (documents requiring the Ophthalmologist's signature, name of disease & official chop) or other claim forms (please note that the above items are subject to additional charges.)
- If you need to apply for the following documents, please take the initiative to ask the Ophthalmologist during the consultation

  Referral letter/medical attendance certificate/sick leave certificate
  (If you have not received it after the consultation, please immediately contact our staff at 1/F counter.)
- Receipts, medical attendance certificates and sick leave certificates are not subject to reissue.

#### **★Important notes for visitor★**

- In response to the call of the Department of Health, people entering the clinic should wear surgical masks.
- Eating and drinking is prohibited within the clinic.
- If you feel unwell on the day of your appointment, you should contact our staff to reschedule your appointment.
- Please use the alcohol hand rub provided in the clinic when you arrive at the Centre.
- It is unfit for driving after dilated pupils.
- In order to avoid crowd gatherings as much as possible, people aged 18 to 60 can only visit the doctor with one accompanying person (People with disabilities, special needs, need to undergo surgery, or those under 18 years old can bring two accompanying person as maximum under the approval of the doctor.)
- In order to reduce the risk of spreading the virus, our Centre has installed the epidemic prevention facilities and strengthened instrument disinfection procedures. Consultation time is expected to be slightly longer.
