Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

Furthermore, due to the nature of cash receipts and expenses relating to general charitable fund-raising activities, it was not practicable for us to determine whether the income and expenditure account and the books and records of the Society include all transactions relating to the Event. It was impracticable for us to quantify the potential impact of this on the income and expenditure account. Accordingly, our report relates solely to the income and expenditure account prepared from transactions that have been recorded in the Society's books and records.

1 General information and purpose of the fund-raising activity – Green Photo Charity Bazaar 2011

- 2 Principal accounting policies
- (a) Income recognition
- (i) Charity sales are recognised when the Society has delivered products to the customer, who has accepted the products and collectability of the related receivables is reasonably assured;
- (ii) Income from donations is recognised upon receipt.
- (b) Expenses

Expenses are recorded on an accrual basis.

3 Taxation

As the Society is registered as a charitable organisation under Section 88 of Inland Revenue Ordinance, the Event is exempted from the Hong Kong profits tax.
